

## **Standards for Minors**

**Approved by the Engineering College Council, 20 April 2017**

A minor is developed by one or more departments within the College, is intended to allow students to develop a competency beyond that developed through a College major, and comprises four key requirements:

1. A statement of purpose and academic content of the minor;
2. At least 15 credits of course work;
3. At least 9 credits of that course work must be beyond degree requirements and beyond the requirements for any other credential (e.g., other minors or majors); and
4. Approval by the relevant committee(s) of the originating department(s) and the College Council, and review by the originating department(s) and the College every three years.
